AUCTION ITEM DESCRIPTIONS:

1. Enjoy a personal **30-minute ride in a World War II Vintage airplane** with pilot Stan Markus. This Stearmon plane, used to train 40,000 pilots in WWII, was featured in the film, "The English Patient." The airplane is located at Crites Field in Waukesha. *(Flight is to be arranged with Stan Markus at a mutually agreed upon day & time.)*
Minimum Bid: \$120 -- This prize will go to the two highest bidders.
2. Two people will enjoy a **30-minute ride, flying formations in the T6 Texan airplane** with pilot Stan Markus. This plane is more powerful than the Stearmon and was used actively in combat in World War II. The airplane is located at Crites Field in Waukesha. *(Flight is to be arranged with Stan Markus at a mutually agreed upon day & time.)*
Minimum Bid: \$200
3. As the Official Airline of the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music and "The Best Care in the Air", this item includes **two round-trip tickets on Midwest Airlines!** ("S"-class ticket vouchers -- some restrictions apply. Expiration: August 31st, 2010.)
Minimum Bid: \$250
4. Wrap yourself up this winter with a one-of-a-kind, beautiful hand-made, **queen sized quilt and** with a lovely musical motif. 73" X 73". Two matching pillows complete this wonderful quilt.
Minimum Bid: \$120
5. **Dazzle** your friends and family with a **private concert performed by classical guitarist Raymond Mueller**, faculty member of the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music. Entertain in your home or another location of your choice. Raymond's repertoire will honor Miguel Llobet, a student of Francisco Tarrega, and the teacher of Andres Segovia. The program will be performed with a rare guitar made in 1925 by Francisco Simplicio. *(Performance is to be arranged with Raymond Mueller at a mutually agreed upon day & time in June, July or August, 2010.)*
