

# SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION REQUIREMENTS WOODWINDS, BRASS, AND PERCUSSION

**Entry Level** – All students must enter and audition in the appropriate age category based on year in school at the time of the audition. Age categories are:

Late Elementary – Grades 3 – 5 Middle School – Grades 6 – 8 High School – Grades 9 – 11 Adult – Grade 12 and Post High School

**Audition Material** – Students will be expected to prepare all the requirements as listed in the appropriate audition category and level.

**Evaluation** – Auditions will be scored on the following elements of musical performance: precision, expression, tone, intonation, technique, interpretation, and technical difficulty. All judges' decisions are final.

**Day of Audition** – Students must provide judges with a clean, published copy of their composition with measures numbered. Judges reserve the right to ask students to skip sections of selections for the sake of time.

## Requirements by Instrument/Age Category

# **Woodwinds and Brass**

## **Late Elementary and Middle School**

- Major and Natural Minor scales and arpeggios up to three flats and three sharps, at least one octave (Students will be asked to play two Major scales and one Minor scale)
- Chromatic scale at least one full octave
- Two contrasting solo pieces or etudes. (Two contrasting movements of the same work are acceptable)

### **High School and Adult**

- All **Major** and **Natural Minor** scales and arpeggios, at least two octaves when possible (students will be asked to play two major scales and two minor scales)
- Chromatic scale, at least two full octaves
- Two contrasting solo works. At least one must be a movement of a sonata or concerto, the other may be an etude or other solo piece. (Two contrasting movements of the same work are acceptable)

#### Percussion

#### **Late Elementary and Middle School**

- Scales
  - Major scales and arpeggios up to three flats and three sharps on a keyboard percussion instrument, at least one octave
  - Chromatic scale at least one full octave on a keyboard percussion instrument
    - NOTE: if a keyboard instrument is not available, the student will demonstrate knowledge
      of the 26 rudiments in lieu of scales.
- Two contrasting solo pieces or etudes for any of the following:
  - Keyboard Percussion
  - Snare Drum (concert or rudimental)
  - Multiple Percussion
  - Drum Set
  - World Percussion
    - NOTE: different instruments for each selection preferred, but not required

#### **High School and Adult**

- Scales
  - All major scales and arpeggios on a keyboard percussion instrument, at least two octaves
  - o Chromatic scale at least two full octaves on a keyboard percussion instrument
    - NOTE: if a keyboard instrument is not available, the student will demonstrate knowledge of the 26 rudiments in lieu of scales
- Contrasting solo pieces or etudes for any of the following:
  - Keyboard Percussion
  - Snare Drum (concert or rudimental)
  - Multiple Percussion
  - Drum Set
  - World Percussion
    - NOTE: different instruments for each selection preferred, but not required
